WHILE YOUR CHILD WORKS

- If Exercise A (alphabet order) is easy but Exercise B (beginning sounds) is hard, the gap is sound recognition, not letter knowledge - worth more time on the phonics sound-match game before moving to blending.
- Say each word in Exercise B and C aloud before your child answers; this is a listening task as much as a writing one.
