#### WHILE YOUR CHILD WORKS

- Read each number aloud before your child answers - Class 2 children often know a number by sound before they recognise it written down.
- If the expanded-form exercise is slow going, lay out ten-rods and single units (or ten-rupee and one-rupee coins) so tens and units stay physical, not just written.
- There is no need to introduce numbers above 100 here - Class 2 does not go there this year.
